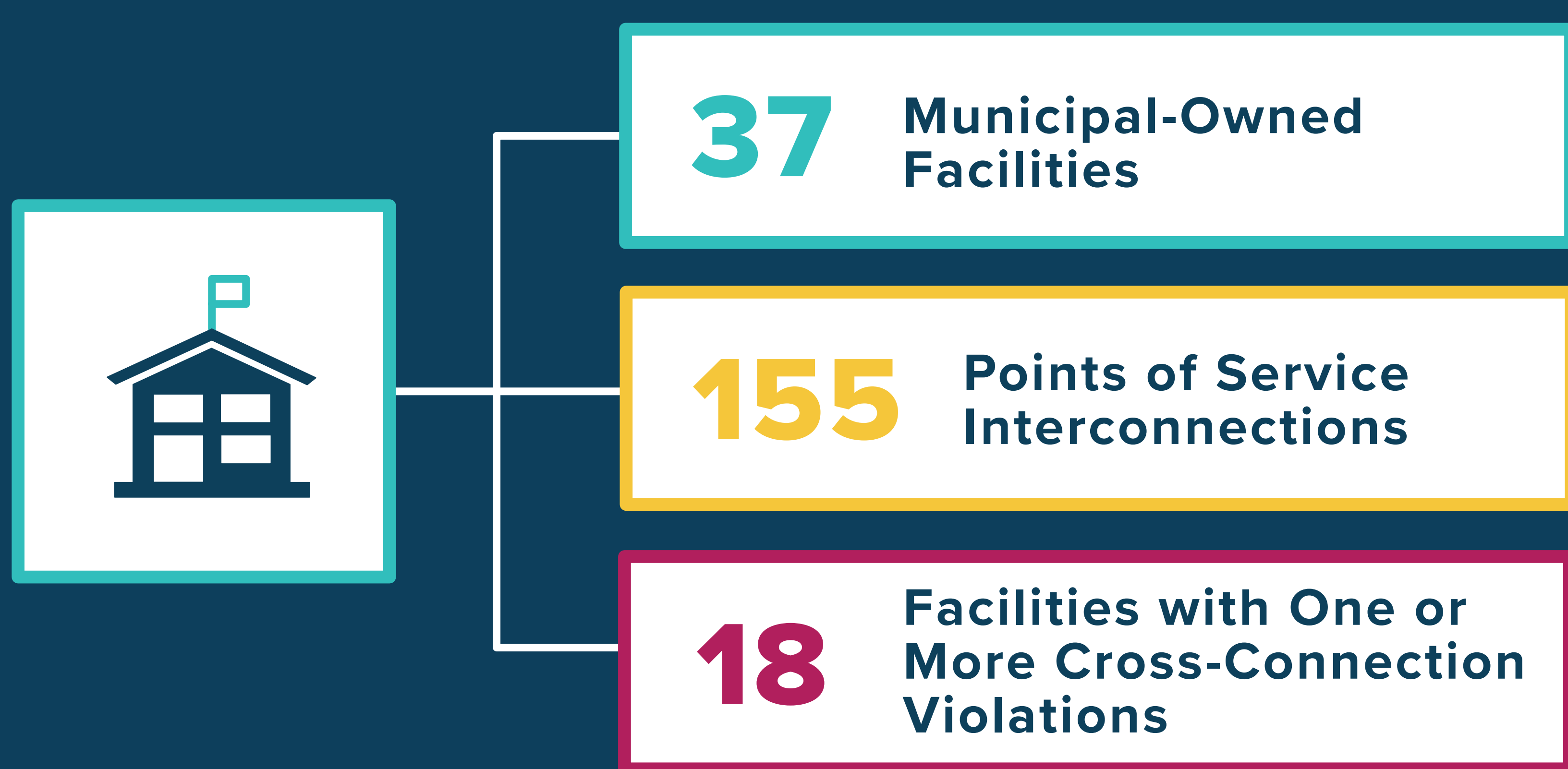


Undetected Cross-Connections, the Risks, & the Right Response

MUNICIPAL SURVEY FINDINGS

In a recent project, HydroCorp worked with a Minnesota municipality to survey 37 public buildings as part of a pilot program. What we found surprised the public works team, who expected full compliance across their facilities:

What we discovered in this suburban community aligns with what we find in utilities of all sizes. If you look for cross-connections, you'll find them—every time.

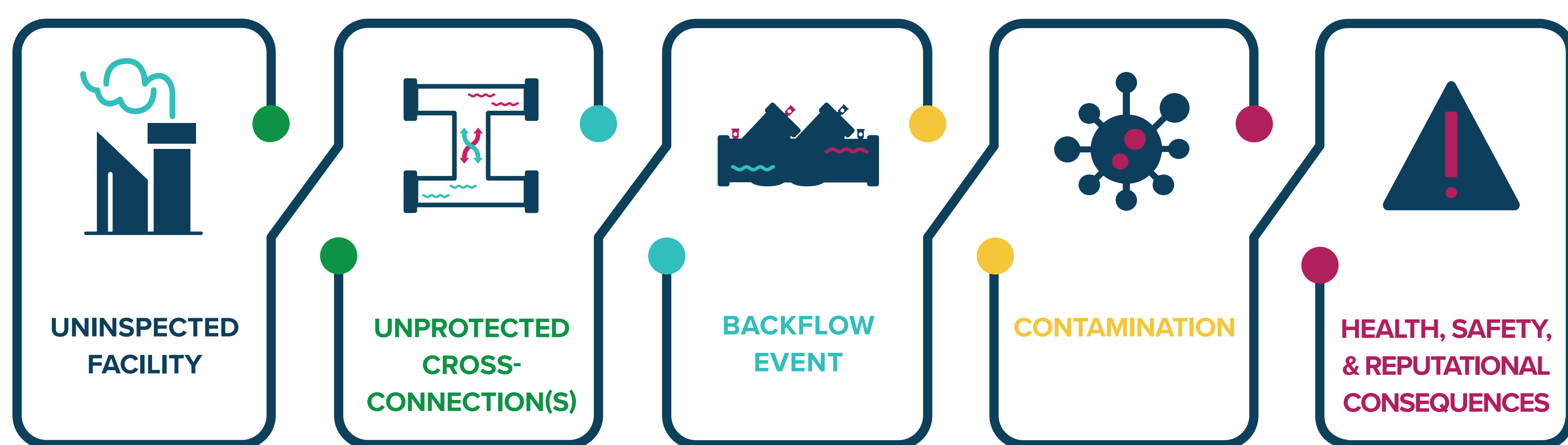
THE COMPLIANCE GAP

If your system hasn't conducted recent on-site surveys across municipal and non-residential facilities, similar risks may already exist.



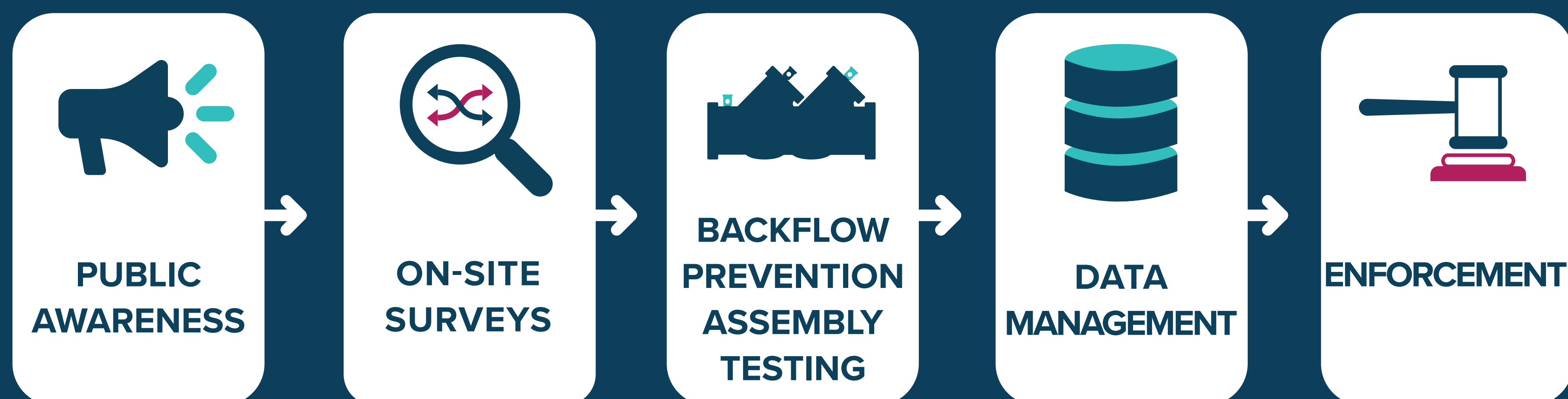
40% of non-residential facilities have unprotected cross-connections at the initial survey
